NIRSA Member Network – Regional Student Leader Time Commitment Overview for Regional Student Leader (RSL)

Membership on the Member Network, specifically the Student Leadership Team (SLT), is an opportunity to enhance the association while growing personally and professionally. With this opportunity, comes responsibility. This document outlines the estimated time commitment for the Regional Student Leader position. The most important aspect to remember is that your responsibilities within your academic and professional pursuits should take priority to these responsibilities.

The Regional Student Leader position time commitment typically ranges from 20-40 hours a month outside of travel. Leading up to the NIRSA Annual Conference more hours may be needed to assist with orientation and preparing for conference activities. Monthly tasks include*: preparing for & attending the monthly SLT & MN meetings, participating in planning and co-leading Regional Leadership Team meetings, assisting with regional communications and committees, participating in Member Network work teams, and responding to emails. In addition, depending on the region the RSL may have high level responsibilities for the Regional Student Lead On.
